

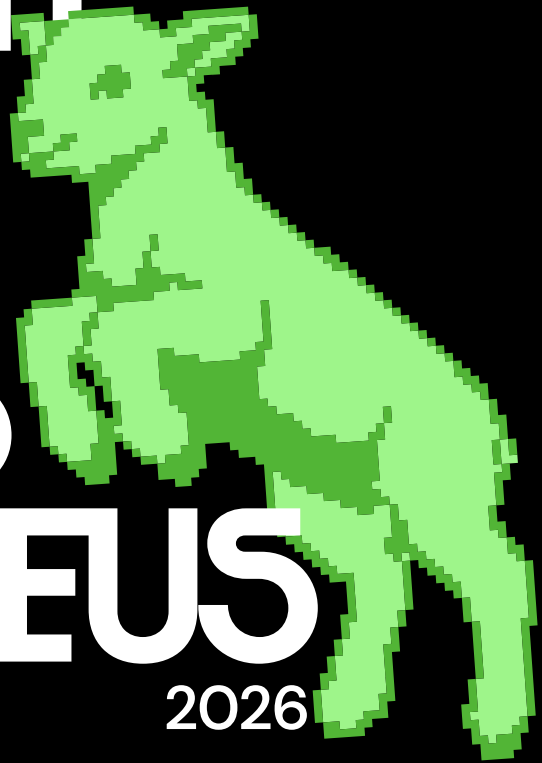

Open house for the permanent collection and temporary exhibitions

Discover the most brilliant sculptor from the Catalan Romanesque period and his masterpiece in the exhibition entitled **Sant Pere de Rodes and the Master of Cabestany.**

The modern art galleries features the exhibitions from the *Art, War and Memory* programme: «*Recuperado del enemigo*». *Deposits at the MNAC under Franco's dictatorship*, *Sim Acquisition, Drawing and War* and *Wounded Militiaman: The Recovery of an Irredeemable Painting*.

In the Romanesque art galleries you will find the **art interventions** *Vesica Piscis*, by Fernando Prats, and *Strappo. The Patriarchy Doesn't Fall by Chance*, by Mar Arza, which aim to create a dialogue between medieval art and our present day.

You can also get to witness the latest additions in the galleries, such as the **never-before-seen display case featuring toys by Joaquim Torres-García.**

Finally, in the Espai Parèntesi, a space dedicated to arts, health and community, you can see a sample of ongoing mediation projects that reinforce the ties between the museum and society.
