## The ten points of the responsible traveller

### 1 Prepare for your trip

### 3 Help conserve the environment

and try to ensure that the footprint of your shoe is the only one you leave behind. If you visit sensitive sites, find out beforehand how to do so.

### 4 Appreciate the

artistic, archaeological and cultural heritage of the destination.

### 5 Choose sustainable suppliers

that respect the environment and human rights when you plan your trip.

### 6 Use natural resources with moderation and

try to minimise waste generation.

### 7 Recycle any waste you generate

If no waste recycling containers are nearby, take your waste home.

### 8 Enjoy the local customs, cuisine and traditions

If you purchase souvenirs, try and purchase those which embody the culture of the place.

### 9 Use local public or collective transport whenever possible

If feasible, use non-motorised transportation and walk as much as possible.

### 10 Open your mind to new experiences

and be tolerant of diversity. Contribute to the development of responsible, fair and sustainable tourism.
